General Class Licensing Course

at the

Wake Tech Beltline Education Center located at 3200 Bush St, Raleigh, NC 27609 in room 404D.

The course will consist of four 5 hour classes and is designed to teach all of the information that is needed to earn the General Class Amateur Radio License and begin enjoying the world wide possibilities of HF communications. Students enrolling in this class must currently hold a Technician Class license.

Capacity is limited to 20 students and registration is required. Due to limited seating no walk-ins will be accepted. Students under age 12 must be accompanied by an adult.

The non-refundable cost for the course is \$10 payable in cash at the first session. There is an additional fee of \$14 for the license test payable on the day of the exam.
