10 Meters	28.350 to 28.400 MHz
12 Meters	24.960 to 24.980 MHz
15 Meters	21.360 to 21.400 MHz
17 Meters	18.140 to 18.145 MHz
20 Meters	14.270 to 14.300 MHz
40 Meters	7.270 to 7.290 MHz
80 Meters	3.740 to 3.940 MHz
2 Meters & 70 Centimeters	Repeaters and simplex are OK.

**Be sure to observe third-party restrictions when making DX QSOs.**

- Make a digital contact.
- Make a contact on the RARS 146.64 repeater (no tone) or 444.525 repeater (82.5 tone).
